PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

WHAT IS SEED?

- SEED is a semi-skilled training program which provides students with accessible, flexible educational and employment opportunities.
- The SEED Program takes 2 years to complete.
- Courses include: communication skills, life skills, and work skills, as well as English, French, and Math.
- Students participate in 2 stages, where they obtain real-world work experience at PACC and in the community as they practice a semi-skilled trade.
- Students benefit from small classes in a highly supportive learning environment.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

STUDENTS MUST:

- be at least 16 years old;
- be ready to attempt Secondary I and II courses in English, French, and Math;
- be able to use public transportation autonomously;
- be in possession of a valid medicare card and proof of Canadian citizenship.
